Body Contouring

Abdominal Liposuction



Use strong even lighting and expose the patient from stomach to thighs. Ask the patient to raise their arms and relax their stomach muscles while you take the picture. Be sure to pull the arms out to the sides for front, and back for the side view.

Back Liposuction



Use strong even lighting and frame your picture to include both stomach and thighs. Ask the patient to raise their arms and while you take the picture. Good full lighting is important. The patient may lower their arms for the back view.

Thigh Liposuction



Use strong even lighting and expose the patient from stomach to knees. A bra and panties can be worn. Ask the patient to raise their arms and spread their legs (until their inner thighs do not touch) while you take the picture.

Hip Liposuction



Use strong even lighting and expose the patient from chest to thighs. Ask the patient to raise their arms and relax their stomach muscles while you take the picture.

Body Contouring


Tummy Tuck



Use strong even lighting and expose the entire abdomen. Ask the patient to raise their arms and relax their stomach muscles while you take the picture.

Breast Reshaping

Breast Augmentation



Oblique View

The breast area should be disrobed for the photo in order to show the full effect of the enlargement, which can include the nipple and shape. We prefer the oblique angle to show a profile of the back breast and a different perspective of the breast closest to the camera.

Facial Sculpting

All Facial Procedures



Front View

Side View

For imaging of facial features, detail is required in the digital photo. Be sure to allow good, strong light on the subject area. Pay attention to sharp focus. Pull hair off the face and ask the patient to remove glasses and jewelry.

Teeth Whitening/Correction



Front View

Whitening and cosmetic correction are common requests for imaging. Remember when taking your pictures to have the subject give a wide smile to show as many front teeth as possible with good lighting.
